Case No. 15-02: In the Matter of the Application of Roxanna Nebraska, LLC, for an Order establishing the rights and equities and pooling of all interests in the Hunton Formation in part of the E/2 SE/4 of Section 7 and part of the E/2 NE/4 of Section 18, Township 1 North, Range 16 East of the 6th P.M., Richardson County, Nebraska, and to provide for proper allocation of costs of development.
